



## Sturgeon Feast for the New Year of Dragon

Served from New Year Eve January 22, 2012 till the Lantern Festival February 6, 2012

Sturgeon appeared in the fossil record approximately 200 million years ago, making it one of the most ancient fishes. Chinese legend has long believed that sturgeon is evolved from the omnipotent, mythical dragon. The Chinese name of sturgeon is 鱈龍 (pronounced hsuin long). 鱈 is composed of two characters. The left part 魚 (yu) is fish. The right part 尋 (hsuin) means "seeking". The word 龍 is dragon. 鱈龍 together means "a fish that is the dragon people are seeking".

To celebrate the New Year of Dragon, Ming's introduces five ways to enjoy sturgeon, the dragon king of water:

Sturgeon Meat with Chasiu Pork, Tofu and Roasted Garlic in Clay Pot

Crispy Sturgeon Skin with Fried Milk

Five Spiced Salt and Pepper Sturgeon Cubes

Sturgeon Fillet Sauteed with XO Chili Sauce and Broccoli
